**Joined our club 2 years ago after attending his first show “Ajax 33”**

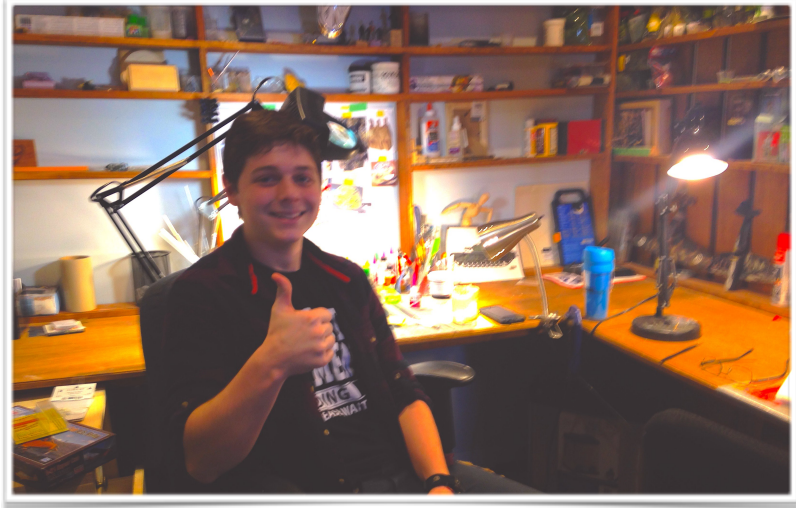
Colin lives in Mississauga, at age 18 he is still in high school. Is other occupation is music, he even plays guitar in a band from time to time.

**A well accomplished modeller.**

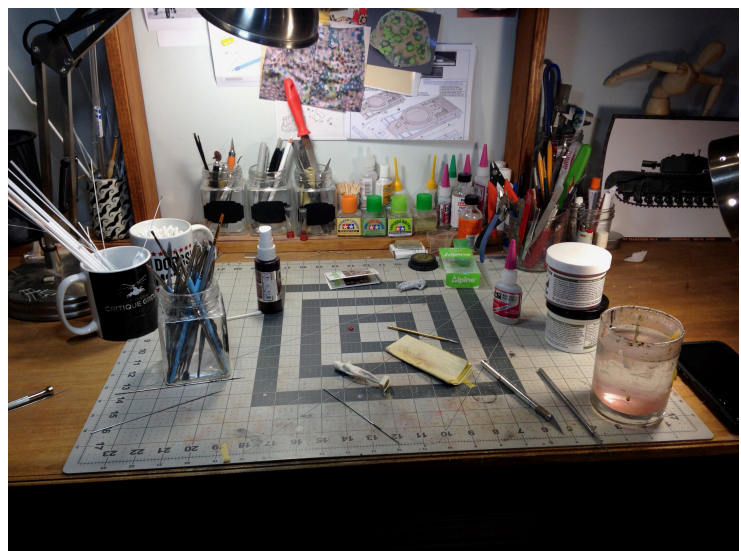
